At the outset, the Chairman Senate welcomed all senate members and special invitees who attended the meeting. Thereafter, the Chairman Senate briefed the evaluation and assesment process undertaken by institute based on the decision of 65th Senate meeting for UG and PG students.

Dean Academic then presented the UG and PG final year results and briefed the statistics of the result, department and programme wise. Dean Academic also apprised about the changes in results for some students of CSE deptt. and inclusion of one more students to have total of 86 students in CSE deptt. instead of 85 students as circulated in agenda item.

The Senate then initiated the discussion on the agenda item and following resolution was adopted.

S-66/20/1: To consider and recommend awarding degrees to all the graduating students (B. Tech., M. Tech., M. Sc., MBA) who have qualified for the same.

Decision:


